### Lodge Rooms

Each lodge room has a queen-size bed and two sets of bunk-beds. With two in the queen bed, the room sleeps six. This year, to ensure plenty of rooms for all, the minimum number in each room will be three. A few of these rooms are designed to be wheelchair accessible and have one queen with only one set of bunk-beds.

### Cabins

Each cabin level sleeps up to nine in one queen, two sets of bunks, a hide-a-bed and a rollaway. A few have only one bath and the others have two. Reserve early!

### Motel Rooms

The motel is the lodging option closest to the dining and conference facilities, though not as well equipped as the lodge. Both motel levels require the use of stairs to reach the rooms. Each room has one queen and two twin beds.

All lodging arrangements must be made through your local POC.
