



“THE KINGDOM OF GOD”

Objective: Women to understand righteousness as a key attribute of God’s kingdom. Impress upon the women that as believers we are now living in the Kingdom of God, for indeed the Kingdom of God is within us. Righteousness is the scepter of our Lord’s kingdom, & we have been made the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. We must now put righteousness (God’s way of doing & being right) into action. Romans 14:17–18 “For the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. For he who serves Christ in these things is acceptable to God and approved by men”.

Scriptural Emphasis:

Psalm 45: 6–7 “Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom”.

Matthew 6:33 “But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”

Decorations: Royalty theme, crowns, scepters, Christian flags, etc...

Speaker Emphasis: Our God is Holy, and righteousness and justice are both foundations of His throne. We are instructed in Scripture to seek righteousness, to pursue righteousness, to practice righteousness, to wear the breastplate of righteousness. We abide in Christ by faith as well as by obedience. When we seek both His kingdom & His righteousness first we experience His peace and joy. We are told we do not have to worry about our life as the people of the world do. He has already given us all things that pertain to life and godliness, and they can be found in the Kingdom of God.
